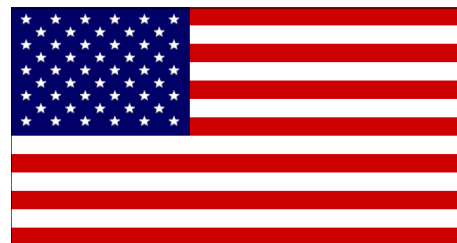


USA FLAG TEST



This test must be passed before the flag is worn on the student's Karate Gi!

1. What are the 3 colors of the flag of the United States of America?

Red, white, and blue.

2. How is the flag treated?

With respect, it never touches the ground. It is always the first, the largest and on the right side of a group. If beyond repair, it is ceremoniously burned.

3. How many Stars does it have?

50. One star for each of the States of the Union.

4. How many stripes does it have?

13. One for each of the original 13 states of the union.

5. What is the “Pledge of Allegiance”?

I pledge allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands, one Nation under God, indivisible, with Liberty and Justice for all. (as of June 14, 1954)



6. What is National Flag Day?

On June 14, 1777, the Continental Congress adopted the stars and stripes pattern for the National Flag of the United States. June 14th is the Flag's birthday, and is now recognized as such.

7. How is the Flag hung on a wall?

With the stars on the observer's top left corner, (on the Flag's right, in the position of respect).

8. What are the Flag's nicknames?

“Old Glory,” the “Star Spangled Banner,” and the “Stars and Stripes.”

9. Where do you sew the flag of the USA on your Karate Gi?

On the left shoulder, an inch under the seam, and above the State flag of Texas.
